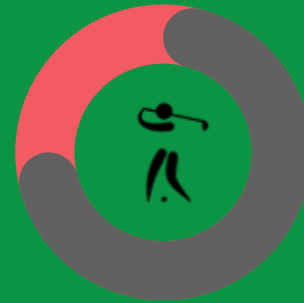
### **YOUTH ON COURSE X TAYLORMADE DRIVE CLUB**

Volunteer program for junior golfers to introduce new players to the game.



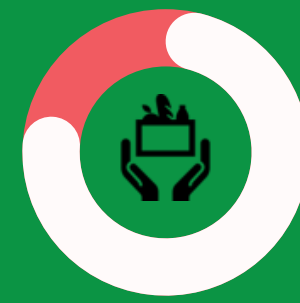

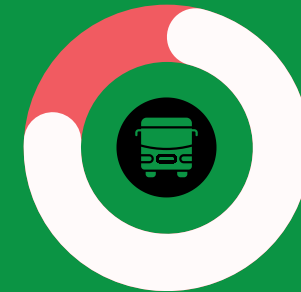

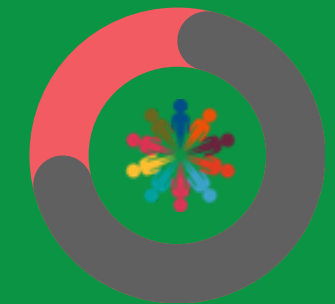
